Lawrence R. Dr. Antonucci's presentation "***The Journey from Entitlement to Accountability--What GCM's need to know about healthcare reform***" will focus on the current state of healthcare delivery and need for redesign of our healthcare delivery system.

Ms. Snow's presentation "***Dementia Care: Learning to Use What is Preserved to Compensate for What is Lost***" will focus on the six major factors that impact the behavior and abilities of a person with dementia, the comparison of lost and preserved skills as dementia progresses and the development of effective helping strategies and environmental supports to assist throughout the disease process.



Lance McKinney, Esq, Osterhout & McKinney, PA, is a certified Elder Law Atty and member of The National Academy Elder Law Attys, The Academy of FL Elder Law Attys, The FL Bar, The Lee County Bar Assoc. and FL State Guardianship Assoc. His practice concentrates in the areas of Medicaid, probate, guardianships, wills and trusts. Mr. McKinney's presentation, "***Standards of Practice and Ethics Relevant to Risk Management***", will focus upon geriatric care management in terms of "best practice" to reduce professional liability.
